### The Feast of St. Everett

Our parish celebrates March 22nd in honor of St. Rita's "little own" St. Everett of Alexandria. Everett died of a brain hemorrhage in 2017 and was buried in a special grave in the churchyard, following the time-honored church tradition of venerating baptized children



who die sinless, before the age of reason. In May 2021, we buried another little saint near Everett, St. Maria Therese, who died at the age of four months, bearing witness to the value of every life. Around the saints' grave, St. Rita has also offered its parishioners a place to bury miscarried children.

In anticipation of St. Everett's feast, all are welcome in the Parish Center on Sunday, March 20 for bagels, donuts, juice, and coffee following the Masses at 8:00 am, 9:15 am, and 11:00 am.

On **Tuesday**, **March 22**, Everett's relic will be displayed on the Marian altar throughout the day. Please feel free to pick up a prayer card in one of the vestibules and pray for the intercession of St. Everett on your behalf.

### Sacred Relics of the Saints: Treasures of the Church

The Basilica of Saint Mary will present a teaching and exposition of Sacred Relics on Tuesday, March 8, at 6:30 p.m. Father Carlos Martins, a Vatican-appointed expert on relics, will attend with an extraordinary Vatican collection of over 150 relics, some as old as 2,000 years. Among the treasures will be relics of St. Joseph, St. Maria Goretti, St. Therese of Lisieux (the "Little Flower"), St. Francis of Assisi, St. Anthony of Padua, St. Thomas Aquinas, and St. Faustina Kowalska. There will also be a portion of the Veil of Our Lady and one of the largest remaining pieces of the True Cross in the world. Those in attendance will be able to examine and venerate each relic. You are encouraged to bring your articles of devotion (such as rosaries, holy cards, etc.) and pictures of ill friends/family members, which you will be able to touch to the reliquaries as a means of intercession.
