#### The Feast of St. Everett



Our parish celebrates March 22nd in honor of St. Rita's "little own" St. Everett of Alexandria. Everett died of a brain hemorrhage in 2017 and was buried in a special grave in the churchyard, following the time-honored church tradition of venerating baptized children who die sinless, before the age

of reason. In May 2021, we buried another little saint near Everett, St. Maria Therese, who died at the age of four months, bearing witness to the value of every life. Around the saints' grave, St. Rita has also offered its parishioners a place to bury miscarried children.

In anticipation of St. Everett's feast, all are welcome in the Parish Center this Sunday, March 20 for bagels, donuts, juice, and coffee following the Masses at 8:00 am, 9:15 am, and 11:00 am.

On **Tuesday, March 22**, Everett's relic will be displayed on the Marian altar throughout the day. Please feel free to pick up a prayer card in one of the vestibules and pray for the intercession of St. Everett on your behalf.
