

About the Design: “Cor ad Cor Loquitur” or “heart speaks to heart” was the apostolic motto selected by St. John Henry Newman, an expression he discovered reading the letters of St. Francis de Sales. This motto comes primarily from Newman’s desire and understanding of the necessity of community as an aid for spiritual growth. In his work “An Essay in Aid of a Grammar of Assent” Newman expresses, “That next to the power and force of supernatural grace, the greatest influence over the human heart is the example of goodness and virtue in another person.” At St. Rita’s Youth Ministry, we see the reality of this expression played out every time our teens gather, in the name of Our Lord. We have many events and opportunities for the youth in our parish to grow in their faith and carry out acts of service, but above all, our greatest desire is that they would enter into a deeper relationship with Christ and their brothers and sisters around them. The words “Cor ad Cor Loquitur” hang on the wall of our youth ministry space for this very reason, so that our teens may always be reminded that the community of faith they are members of is one they are invited to be members of for eternity when “heart speaks to heart”.

We want to invite all of you to adopt this same mission in your own life and you can do so by supporting our Youth Ministry Shirt fundraiser. All proceeds from this fundraiser will go towards supporting the Middle and High School Youth Ministry at St. Rita so that we can continue to be able to offer opportunities for our teens to grow in their relationship with Christ and one another.

**Wednesdays** from **6:15 - 7:15 pm**, starting **September 10**


- Students in the **Second Year** of Sacramental Preparation
